
- 1. Email or call the teacher first.



LDSS STUDENT ABSENCE AND HOMEWORK

Teaching and learning today are interactive and experiential in nature much of the time. Participation in discussion and activities are part of the learning and assessment. For learners to fully engage in the instruction they need to be in class. The classroom experience cannot be "packaged up" and sent home in most cases.

School policy for homework for missed classes is as follows:

- 1. Students must see the teacher outside of class time upon return and arrange a time to go over missed learning and assignments.
- 2. Students are expected to use Friday mornings (8:47 9:30) and their own time to complete missed work.
- 3. Many teachers have websites or email set up to assist students with missed classes.
- 4. For an extended absence, an alternate project may be assigned.
- 5. Except in rare circumstances, assignments will not be provided ahead of time.
- 6. Homework will not be provided on a day-to-day basis for absences.
- 7. For complex or extended absence, parents are encouraged to contact one of our school counsellors.
- 8. Parents must report student absence to the office (it is not sufficient to tell the teacher).
