FIELD TRIP PERMISSION REQUEST

On May 24th, students in grade 11 & 12 Environmental Science classes will be provided with an amazing opportunity to participate in outdoor learning. These activities will take place during the school day. Students will be gone for the full day. We will not be back until after dismissal, approximately 6:00pm. We will be leaving Driftwood Canyon Provincial Park at 4:00pm and it takes about 1 hour and 46 minutes from there to Burns Lake.



This is <u>entirely optional</u> for the students. The minibus will be used for this event, meaning 23 students are able to attend. Those who submit their permission forms first will be able to go.

A rough itinerary:

- Leaving LDSS by 9:00am
- Nature walks at Tyhee Lake or Call Lake Provincial Park

On site at Driftwood for a 3-hour period from 1pm to 4pm.

- Viewing BC Parks fossil specimens
- Viewing local shale/rock from fossil beds
- Discussion: Statement of Significance and Management Direction for Driftwood Canyon Provincial Park
 - Students will be asked to put on their BC Parks Management hats and discuss how they would manage the fossil resource at Driftwood given the current management pressures.
- Discussion: Management Direction Statement
 - Explain in greater detail the conservation, recreation, and cultural values for Driftwood Canyon
- Activity: Team Investigation
- Activity: Short walk to viewpoints and interpretive signage
- Discussion: Talk about our roles in BC Parks
 - Day in the life of a Park Ranger, Conservation Biologist, Supervisor, and other roles (Possibly a Conservation Officer as well).
