RACE REGULATIONS:

- All racers must wear helmets at all times.
- NO race boards for snowboarders at zones
- The event is GS. The combined time of the two runs will be used to determine a participant's final result.
- The four best results are used to calculate team results.
- We will be using an intermediate level run.
- We have both GS gates and snowboard gates
- Late entrants or entrant changes will be added to the bottom of each category.
- The racing order will be random and reversed for the second run.
- Race Rules are the same as CSA rules as per the BC School Sports Handbook.
- A racer is allowed to finish with three pieces of equipment. Once the next racer passes a fallen racer, the fallen racer may not re-enter the race.
- Protests against any decisions made must be made by the coach and accompanied by a \$50 fee, which will be returned if the protest is won.
- Disqualifications will be posted at the club cabin after the completion of each run. Protests must be made within fifteen minutes, and accompanied by a \$50 protest fee.
- All decisions, with respect to the race rules, will be dealt with by the members of the jury.
- The Jury will be comprised of:
 - Chief of Race- Cormac Hikisch
 - o Referee- TBD
 - Finish Referee/Chief of Gates- TBD
 - Start Referee- TBD
- Please feel free to contact the Chief of Race if anything else requires clarification.
- The top three individuals in each category, as well as the top three teams in each category, qualify for provincials.
