□ Reference letters
☐ Any additional information or applications requested by
individual awards (essays for example)

WHAT TO INCLUDE IN YOUR LETTER OF INTENT

Your letter should specify the following:

- Intended course of studies or career option (include the name of post-secondary school if you have applied or have conditional acceptance). Is it an out of province school?
- School activities you were involved in (sports teams, specialized programs such as dance or drama, Student Voice, Career Projects, Grad committee, score keeping, time keeping etc.)
- School achievements or awards you received (Honor roll, honor roll with distinction, Fine Arts, academic awards, athletic achievements etc.)
- Community involvements (include community awards, volunteer work, sports, coaching, work, extra - curricular activities etc.)
- Emphasize special circumstances or qualifications not already noted in the above prompts. A typewritten response is preferred.
