For graduates and their families, the important information is as follows:


- Gown pick up will begin on Thursday, June 16<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am (pending timely arrival).

For the student body, on Commencement Day:


- Regular classes are held in the morning.

#### **Mountain Bike Team Competes at Provincials**

The LDSS Mountain Biking team just returned from Provincials in Langford. They competed on Friday, May 27. 13 students from LDSS participated. There were over 400 racers from all over the province.

Grade 8/9's completed two laps (approximately 7 km) of the cross-country and two courses of the Enduro (approximately 6km).

Grades 10-12's completed four laps (approximately 13 km) of the cross-country loop and three courses of the Enduro (approximately 10 km).

The courses were demanding and we had a few crashes, but the kids had fun. We are very proud of the students considering our trails weren't open for them to train on before they competed at the Provincial Championships.
